8. Any other matter — *Planning for next academic year*



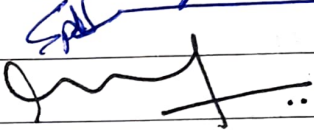

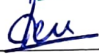


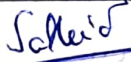



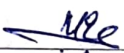

Decisions taken in the meeting –

1. The opinions expressed by the members of status committee at the time of exit meeting are discussed. It has been decided to strengthen the weak areas identified by the team.
2. Members expressed the opinion that the college has to try for grants from various government and non-government agencies for the research activities under the research cell.
3. It has been suggested to constitute an advisory committee for the research cell.
4. It has been decided to conduct training programmes to PG students and newly recruited staff to clear NET/SLET.
5. Members suggested to have more MoUs for the benefit of our students.
6. It has been decided to continue with existing certificate courses to the students and to introduce more such courses if required.

8. It has been decided to have green audit /energy audit/environment audit of the college campus through a qualified external agency.
9. It has been suggested to maintain service register of all employees in the required format.
10. It has been suggested to follow the process of getting the research centre of the college registered under Mangalore University.
11. Decision has been taken to continue with all the activities of various associations, placement & training cell and all the departments. It has also been decided to have all extension activities and outreach programmes of the college this year also.


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
